## ICE Announced Increased Fees for International Students, Exchange Visitors, and SEVP-Certified Schools

Friday, May 24, 2019

ICE announced that, effective June 24 2019, fees paid to the Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) by international students, exchange visitors and SEVP-certified schools will increase as follows:

- The I-901 SEVIS Fee for F and M international students will increase from \$200 to \$350.
- The I-901 SEVIS Fee for most J exchange visitors will increase from \$180 to \$220. (The \$35 I-901 SEVIS Fee for J exchange visitors in the au pair, camp counselor, and summer work travel program participant categories will remain the same.)
- The SEVP school certification petition fee for initial certification will increase from \$1,700 to \$3,000.

The following new fees will be imposed:

- A \$1,250 fee for SEVP-certified schools filing a petition for recertification.
- A \$675 fee for schools filing Form I-290B, "Notice of Appeal or Motion."
- A \$650 fee when a SEVP-certified school changes its physical location or adds a new physical location or campus to its Form I-17, "Petition for Approval of School for Attendance by Nonimmigrant Student. (DHS will maintain the \$655 fee for an initial school site visit).
