

## Section 301 Tariffs Update: USTR Announces List 3 Product Exclusion Process

On June 24, 2019, the Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) [officially announced](#) a product exclusion process for List 3 of the Section 301 tariffs, which imposes 25% tax on US\$200 billion worth of products from China.

**June 30, 2019:** USTR will begin accepting exclusion requests through a new web portal.

**September 30, 2019:** Deadline for submitting exclusion requests.

USTR is requiring more extensive information for List 3 product exclusions than it did for Lists 1 and 2. The full questionnaire is available as an annex to today's [Federal Register Notice](#).
